The Manawatu District Council's logo has a flowing style of "M" which endeavours to give the feeling of the district, stretching from the ranges through the plains, to the sea. The "M" moves over five diagonal bars representing the former councils that make up the Manawatu district.

The district stretches from Rangiwahia in the north to Himatangi Beach and Palmerston North in the south. The western boundary is the Rangitikei River and the eastern boundary the Ruahine Ranges.

## Manawatu District Solid Waste Services 2011

### REFUSE BAG COLLECTION:

**Official blue bags \$1.50 each recommended retail price.** Bags must be out by 7.30am on collection day.

**Feilding** – Households Wednesday or Thursday,  
Commercial area Monday and Thursday.

**Sanson, Himatangi Beach, Rongotea, Longburn, Tangimoana** – Monday.

**Cheltenham, Kimbolton, Waituna West, Rangiwahia, Apiti** – Wednesday.

**Halcombe, Bunnythorpe, Pohangina** – Thursday.

**Rural Roads** – contact Council for availability and collection day.

### RECYCLING:

A kerbside recycling collection is available in Feilding for plastic bottles, cans, paper, cardboard and glass. Put recyclables out in plastic supermarket bags by 7.30am on the same day refuse bags are collected. Plastic bottles and cans can be put together in the same bag. Put glass in a separate bag and tie paper and cardboard with string or put in a separate plastic supermarket bag. Other plastic containers (eg ice cream, margarine and yoghurt) and plastic bags are not collected as recyclables. Only plastics with recycling symbols 1 and 2 are collected. Recycling drop off centres for cardboard, paper, plastic bottles, tin cans, aluminium cans and glass are available at all refuse transfer stations and also at Pohangina (Finnis Road) and Sanson Library (Dundas Road), Tangimoana (Tangimoana Beach Road) and Himatangi Beach (Koputara Road).

**Feilding** Kawakawa Road, 1 km from South Street, open Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm and Saturday/Sunday 9am to 5pm

**Southern** Kaimatarau Road (110m off SH 1), Saturday 10am to 4pm

**Northern** London Street (off Edwards St), Kimbolton, Saturday 10am to 4pm

**Central** Waughs Road, Bunnythorpe, Saturday 10am to 4pm
